The visitor information centre was created inside a former boat builder's workshop and included a display of boat building tools and a large fabric banner showing visitors the range of places of interest to visit along the Llangollen Canal.



Site panels, with text in both English and Welsh, were framed in steel structures which reflected the sections of ironwork on Pontcysyllte Aqueduct.

Furniture maker, Ashley Cartwright, worked with us to design and install an oak seat adjacent to the visitor centre. The seat was constructed using shapes and joinery techniques used in traditional narrowboat construction.
